For sweet treats, there is 'Queen Victoria's Sponge', a nod to Queen Victoria's sweet tooth, the dessert she was served many times during her visits to Cliveden House to meet with the Duchess of Sutherland. Her beloved Prince Albert is also featured on the afternoon tea menu with the eponymous 'Albert's Pudding'. You will find the delicious

'Lady Cranborne Chocolate Mousse', a favourite at many Astor banquettes; and the 'Garibaldi Biscuit', which pays

tribute to the Italian patriot Giuseppe Garabaldi, who when visiting Cliveden in April 1864 is alleged to have sat on

two biscuits when waiting to meet politician and journalist Joseph Cowen, squashing them together, and thus the

Garibaldi biscuit was born! Of course, no afternoon tea is complete without a selection of warm home-made plain

and fruit scones, served with clotted cream and the finest strawberry jam.

Guests can also choose from an extensive selection of teas, including the original 'Cliveden Blend', 'Virunga

Afternoon Tea' and 'Virunga Earl Grey', together with many more, each selected for their unique flavour and

historical significance. For those looking to elevate their afternoon tea experience, Cliveden House offers the option

to include a glass of Laurent-Perrier Héritage Champagne or the indulgent 'Berry Explosion Cocktail'.

Guests can experience the delight of the new Cliveden afternoon tea in the splendid surroundings of the Cliveden

Dining Room, which overlooks the celebrated Parterre Gardens, part of the 376 acres of National Trust gardens that

surround this wonderful property, and which can be explored at leisure during a visit to Cliveden House for afternoon

flowers, to the quirky statuary and topiary of the Long Gardens, or the heavenly scent of the Rose Garden and Long
